6.1 PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

Mrs Anita Campbell addressed Council regarding the "Tweety Bus":-

Recently Deputy Mayor Lana Benson contacted me regarding the bus which is currently under control of United Care. The issue that has been raised is the housing of the vehicle and has been an on-going conversation for the last few months about moving it to Bothwell instead of Ouse.

At the moment the logistics are difficult and she was hoping that Council may be able to help with this. It is an opportunity for the community, when this vehicle changes hands, to have more control but the administration side of the vehicle service is uncertain.

Would it be possible for Council, during the transition period where Uniting Care transfer it to Council and help out the community until such time as another community group takes on the bus service?

Clr R L Cassidy asked:

If the vehicle is moved to Bothwell where will it be kept? Who will be able to drive it?

Deputy Mayor L Benson responded:

There are on-going meetings regarding this but the housing of the vehicle isn't the issue. The issue is who will take care of the administration side of it (eg. bookings, invoicing etc). There will be further information available by the next Council Meeting for Councillors.

CIr E McRae stated:

Council does have a responsibility to the local community to help out with Health Care in the Central Highlands and to help people with getting to appointments and having access to health care. This is a big part of what this vehicle will be used for in the future.

Mr Chris Tassell addressed Council regarding the Bothwell Literary Society Library:-

The Library is currently is very poor condition and many books are missing. How does Council want to address this issue? There are options within the report in the agenda for you to decide.

CIr R L Cassidy stated:

He has been to the Library and viewed the situation. Is there any way to have the books on loan from another entity? Answer – no institution would take on the books as a loan only, you would have to completely donate all to them.

CIr E McRae stated:

She has read the report and found it very interesting. It would be great to keep a few small books on display only if possible.

Is there any way of preventing a third party on selling the books? Answer – yes I can be made a condition of them taking on the collection.
