- 10. Undertake approved private works/private hire in a manner acceptable to both Council and the client.
- 11. Working safely in compliance with the Workplace Health & Safety Act 2012 and Council's policies and procedures.
- 12. To undertake any task, within the limit of the employees skill and training as directed by the leading hand or manager
