Frontline health staff at higher risk (e.g. key emergency, ICU, vaccination, testing and ambulance staff)

Residents and staff at aged and disability residential care facilities*

* The Australian Government will manage these vaccinations.



Phase 1B

People aged 70+ years

Other health care workers

All Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 18+ years

Critical and high-risk workers including defence, police, fire, emergency services and meat processing

Adults with underlying medical conditions



Phase 2A

People aged between 50–69 years

Other critical and high-risk workers



Phase 2B

Remaining Tasmanians aged 18+ years



Phase 3: Tasmanian children if clinically recommended and approved.
