BushFest Basics

ENTRY

Entry is by gold coin donation. If you didn't bring cash, EFTPOS facilities are available at the Central Highlands Council (CHC) Information Tent.

ATM FACILITIES

An ATM is available inside the Recreation Rooms.

TOILET FACILITIES

Toilets are located throughout the festival grounds as well in the Recreation Rooms and under the Grandstand. .

FIRST AID

The First Aid marquee is located in front of the gated children's playground. In emergencies, contact Festival staff, Security, or Police.

LOST PERSONS

If a child becomes separated, report immediately to the CHC Information Tent, or speak to Festival staff, Lions Club volunteers, or Security. It's recommended to show your child the CHC tent location.

LOST PROPERTY

Found items can be handed to the CHC Information Tent, staff, or at the Gate.

Designated parking, ATM, water refill stations, and restroom facilities are available for all visitors. Free Wi-Fi is available throughout the event grounds via NBN



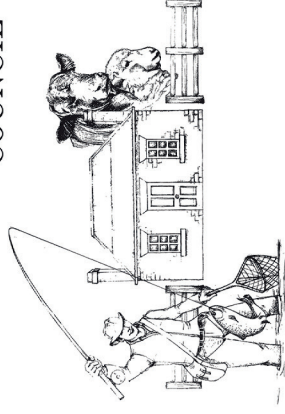

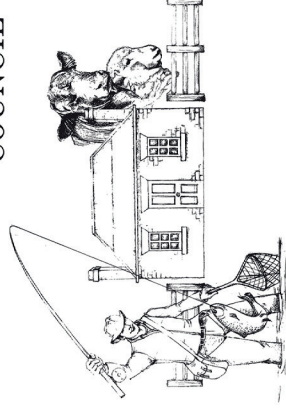
